- •Thanks for your support of the 8th grade/Jazz II/Freshman Band concert in January. We were proud of the bands and impressed by the large, enthusiastic crowd.
- •This Friday is the last basketball game for pep band. We will be performing at the Honor Flight, April 27, as well.
- Saturday, February 9, is Council's Band Dance for the senior bands. 7-10 p.m. in the B gym.
- •Solo & Ensemble is a week from this Saturday on February 16. Ensembles will begin performing in band classes later this week. We anticipate having a schedule to share by the end of this week. Thank you again for supporting this important educational event.
- •On February 18, two members of Council will be presenting the board with a framed picture of the band marching down the street in Manhattan. They will also make a few comments about how valuable the trip was. Thanks to Mrs. Klamfoth for framing the photo.
- •Several of our students are playing in the pit orchestra for *Beauty and the Beast* on February 22–24, including Emily Miller, Ephraim Baturin, Catie Ryan, and Nate Asamoah. Several more are in the cast or on crew.
- •The Prism Concerts will be on Sunday, March 3rd, with Blue and Silver playing at 3:00 and Freshman and Gold playing at 6:00.
- District Contest will be March 8–9 at Thomas Worthington High School. We have requested that Freshman Band perform on Friday evening and the other bands perform on Saturday. We will need chaperones.
- •Three new double horns were purchased with GLIMB funds at \$2700 each. We found a good deal through Buckeye Brass and Winds where they got a discount through the factory because they had minor cosmetic flaws (which I cannot find). These horns list at \$4800 and Mr. Tuomaala says they play great. We needed them because of growth in the horn section. Another one was purchased with board funds.
- •I have asked Mrs. Squillante to look into reframing/restoring/preserving some of the photos in the band room. Alumni frequently come in and look for friends and family members in those photos, and some of them are not aging well. We don't want them to continue to fade. Thanks, Mrs. Squillante!

Currently 8th grade students are beginning the scheduling process at all three middle schools, and we recently surveyed them about their plans and their experience with the All-District 8th Grade Band. - •We have welcomed a student teacher, Miss Stephanie DePauw, at Middle School West in addition to the work she is doing at the high school. Miss DePauw is a clarinet player and comes to us from Bowling Green State University and Olentangy Orange High School. She has worked with the 7th and 8th grade full band classes and has observed a variety of sectionals, along with the Woodwind Choir and Jazz Band after school. We look forward to involving her more with our middle school students in the coming weeks and months.
- •Coming up soon... To prepare for our performances at Solo and Ensemble on February 16, we are planning a Percussion Recital Night on Tuesday, February 12 at 5:30. All percussion ensembles and soloists will have a chance to perform that evening in the band room. Additionally, we are organizing a trip to the OSU Percussion Ensemble Festival to attend either the Opening Concert on February 22 or the Closing Concert on February 23, where we will get to see alum Krista Staten in action!
- Also on the weekend of Solo and Ensemble, OSU is holding its Middle School Honor Band (Saturday, February 16). MSW students Isabelle Laser (clarinet), Jesse Briggs (alto saxophone), and Finn Devine (bassoon) will be part of those ensembles, which will each have the opportunity to work with composer Larry Clark.
- •The MSW 6th Grade Band, Woodwind Choir, 7th Grade Band, and Jazz Band are preparing for their performances at the Winter Band Concert on Thursday, February 28 at 7:30 in the MSW Auditorium. The 6th graders are getting more comfortable playing in multiple parts on full band music, while the 7th grade band is making excellent progress on some challenging music, including a suite of Renaissance dances. The Woodwind Choir (which includes at least one of every woodwind instrument this year) will be performing portions of *New World Symphony*, and the Jazz Band will appear for the first time this year, featuring a number of improvised solos.
- •Students at MSW are beginning to look ahead to OMEA Solo and Ensemble Adjudicated Event, which will be held on Saturday, April 13 at Central Crossing High School. All 8th grade band members will be part of a chamber music unit in class, with the option to take their ensemble to the OMEA event for extra credit. Students in 7th grade will be invited to join ensembles to rehearse before and after school, and all students who are studying privately are encouraged to perform solos at this event. Information about Solo and Ensemble is being sent home this week, and students will begin working on ensemble music later this month. Thanks for all you do!
