- Since last we met, band and orchestra families have purchased \$10,075 in Giant Eagle and Kohl's gift cards, earning $\$ 503.75$ for student trip accounts. - Some families asked that their student accounts be transferred to the General Trip Fund, as they no longer have students in the program. Those transfers totaled $\$ 315.30$.

-Happy New Year! The Chamber Orchestra had a wonderful performance at the Gahanna Holiday Lights event in November.
