#### Assistant Treasurer's Report—Maria Becker

- •Since last we met, band and orchestra families have purchased \$10,075 in Giant Eagle and Kohl's gift cards, earning \$503.75 for student trip accounts.
- •Some families asked that their student accounts be transferred to the General Trip Fund, as they no longer have students in the program. Those transfers totaled \$315.30.
- •A \$1290.50 payment to Bob Rogers was made from the General Trip Fund to finalize the balance from the New York trip in November. Anything we did to help kids out for the NYC trip came from the General Trip Fund.
- •Current Trip account balances total \$1946.60 in student accounts and \$1977.57 in the General Trip Fund.

- •The 8th Grade Bands from all three middle schools have been working on music for their combined 8th Grade District Band concert this coming Sunday afternoon. We will have two rehearsals at GLHS to prepare for the performance. The first will be this coming Friday afternoon, culminating in a pizza dinner/social time. Thank you, GLIMB, for providing food and drinks for this rehearsal! The second rehearsal will be on Sunday. The performance will be on 1/13/19 at 4:00pm in the GLHS Auditorium and will be shared with Jazz II and Freshman Band.
- •The 6th Grade band just had their first performance right before winter break. It was a "show and tell" style performance and the students enjoyed this new experience. They will continue to learn new notes and rhythms in preparation for their next performance on February 26th.
- •The 7th Grade band has had a big focus on learning and memorizing scales. They will begin to work on music for the February concert in the next few days.
- •The MSS Jazz Band has gotten off to a great start. There are a lot of students involved and they are very enthusiastic about playing.
- •The MSS Woodwind Choir joined forces with MSW and MSE to play Christmas Carols for the residents at The Worthington, just before winter break. This was a wonderful way to spend the afternoon. We played about 20 minutes worth of carols, then spent time visiting with the residents, and finished by playing a few more carols. They received a lot of compliments on their playing and behavior, and many thanks for sharing their music from the residents.

#### Mr. Cebriak—Lincoln High School bands

- •Happy New Year! Thanks to one and all for a successful and educational NYC trip! DVD's of uploaded photos will be distributed to students this week. Chaperones' photos will be sent home with students or you can have them tonight. We had about a dozen extra coat sales, mostly for parents and siblings. These have all been paid and almost all have been picked up. We still have an XS for \$40.
- •We received a refund on the 9/11 Memorial tickets from the bus company through Bob Rogers. I have deposited those into the GLIMB account. I also requested some of that money be put toward Zac Forsythe's plane ticket. I would suggest that the remaining funds be put toward an instrument or equipment purchase.
- •Everyone seemed happy with the new Holiday Lights format with the fanfare and sing-a-long, so we will plan to do something similar next year.
- •Quintessence played for the Schoedinger Memory Service in December. A contribution has been deposited.
- •Thanks to Mandi Shirley for heading up the spiritwear sale. Several people have talked to me about wanting to order more or missing the sale, so we will re-open it early this year.
- •Pep Band has had three games so far, with the next being this Friday. Students really seem to enjoy this activity and it's a great opportunity for our freshmen to interact with senior band members.
- •Thanks for your support at the Holiday concert. We are proud of the performances of all three bands, and thanks to Dave Prater and Deb Bowles for organizing the poinsettias for the stage. They looked great! Thanks also to Stonybrook United Methodist Church's bell choir for allowing us to borrow their handbells for the concert opener. With the concert behind us, the three senior bands have begun preparation for the Prism concert and district contest.

- •8<sup>th</sup> grade district/Freshman Band Concert is this Sunday. Freshman Band will be playing quite an eclectic program including *March Diabolique* and *Dance of the Trolls.* I echo comments made by Mr. Bradshaw and Mr. Miller.
- •Ensembles are running and soloists have finished getting information to us. We will complete our registration for the school and be making a request for the entry funds from GLIMB. We anticipate somewhere around 75 solos and 40 ensembles. The solo and ensemble event will take place at Pickerington North HS on Saturday, February 16.
- •Several students will be a part of the OSU Honor Band Festival on Martin Luther King, Jr. weekend. They include Matt Bartter, Corrina Bowles, Benjamin Brody, Shaelyn O'Brien and Seth Stemen.
- •We have an amazing and supportive booster organization. Thank you to each and every one of you for making great opportunities available to our students!

Mr. Dengel—Lincoln High School orchestras, Middle School East Orchestra

- Happy New Year! The Chamber Orchestra had a wonderful performance at the Gahanna Holiday Lights event in November.
- •Thank you, GLIMB, for sponsoring our seventh grade band and orchestra students to attend the OSU Celebration Concert.
- •We had a very successful order for orchestra spiritwear (90 orders collected in December). The order is still being processed and should be completed in the next week.
- •The trip itinerary for OMEA PDC in Cleveland (Feb. 1-2) has been finalized. The traveling party includes 37 people. Dinner has been sponsored. Payments from travelers continue to be collected.

We have added four evening rehearsals in preparation for our OMEA performance.

- •NYC 2020 trip enrollment is ongoing. We are beginning to identify repertoire to perform, likely to highlight the Harlem Renaissance, Tin Pan Alley, and music of immigrant composers.
- •Chamber Orchestra has been invited to attend (and possibly play) at the Gahanna Chamber of Commerce meeting on January 17. Janet Chen and David Danzmyer from the ProMusica Chamber Orchestra will be presenting.

- •Since last we met... Percussion ensemble has begun rehearsing at the high school we are preparing six separate pieces for OMEA Solo and Ensemble on February 16, and several groups of students are working on separate selections for Varsity Varieties auditions as well. Families will be finding out about whether their students have been accepted within the next week.
